WHAT IS A SHEPHERD?

Last year, our church embarked on a strategic vision initiative for discipleship at Christ Covenant. One of the key components that we have been working on is the work of shepherding. Shepherding is patterned after God himself (Psalm 23) and is seen in the ministry of Jesus as the chief shepherd (1 Peter 5:4). In the church, the work of shepherding is done especially through the ministry of elders (1 Timothy 3 & Titus 1). We might be tempted to think of elders as administrators or members of a “board.” However, as shepherds under Christ, the role of an elder is more than a mere decision-maker. His role is to serve the Lord’s people by guiding them into spiritual well-being and growth. At Christ Covenant, we believe this requires a vital relationship between the elders and the congregation. To that end, we want to connect every member to an elder, who has the care of their soul as his primary responsibility. We look forward to sharing more in the coming months about our design for shepherding and the heart of a shepherd.
