IN PREPARATION FOR WORSHIP

Our service today highlights two contrasting themes. Our preaching passage clearly points to physical death entering the human experience. Human blood was spilled in hate and jealousy. The separation from God continues to be painfully evident. To contrast this, the opening hymn proclaims the death of death, while the second points to blood spilled that accomplished a reunion with God. Also, through man comes death, but the text of our new song beautifully points to one man who overcame death. Blood spilled in hate gives way to blood given in love. One brings death. The other brings life forevermore.


