Prayer Guide for the week of November 28, 2021

Sunday – Our Families and Neighbors - Pray this week for neighbors, co-workers, or family members you can invite to join you for our Christmas Carol Concert next Sunday evening, December 5. If you've wanted to build friendships with the people you pray for there's no easier time to include them in your plans than during the Christmas season.

Pray for the children to be invited to Christian events where they can hear the gospel.
