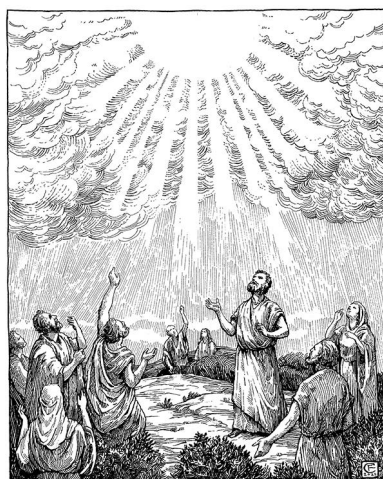
‘O NIGHTS’

MINISTRY HIGHLIGHT: DEACONS' SPECIAL OFFERING JONI AND FRIENDS

Our deacons' special offering today is for Joni and Friends. Joni & Friends is an international ministry founded in 1979 to address the needs of families affected by disabilities. This ministry traces its roots to one day in 1967 when 17-year-old Joni Eareckson Tada's life was changed forever in a diving accident. In God's providence, Joni's own story of that accident, her quadriplegia, and her search for God's purpose became a best-selling book. The book was followed by a movie reaching audiences in theaters, church halls, and homes around the country. God had given Joni a platform that allowed her to talk about God's love for his children, and a vision for using that platform to share God's love with people who share her life-altering challenges.

Today, with more than forty years of experience and an international reputation for excellence, Joni & Friends focuses on advancing the disability ministry and changing the church and communities around the world. Their mission is to communicate the gospel and equip Christ-honoring churches worldwide to evangelize and disciple people affected by disabilities. Their record of service gives them a voice on issues that affect people with disabilities.

Here in Charlotte, the Joni & Friends regional office is a welcomed partner in our own church's ministry. We are grateful for the opportunity to share their resources with our families. Those resources include Wheels for the World, Family Retreats, International Family Retreats, Cause for Life global missions and internships, church engagement, the Christian Institute on Disability, and media programming including Joni's radio program and the weekly Joni & Friends ministry podcast. We appreciate their engagement with Christ Covenant, including their input on ways to make our church more welcoming and our campus more accessible.

Your gift today will be used by Joni & Friends to expand ministries to families and individuals who do not have the means to take part in family retreats and to expand the availability of wheelchairs and other equipment that improve their quality of life. Pray for Joni & Friends evangelistic outreach and mercy ministries. Pray for Joni Eareckson Tada and her husband, Ken, as they work closely with Joni's doctors to monitor her health concerns.
