- 2) Our daughter Emily is suffering the effects of long-covid, with significantly decreased energy and strength just for daily tasks, not to mention her psychotherapy work, mostly with minors. She knows she has intervened in a number of potential suicides, as well as with clients (mostly children) who have suffered serious emotional trauma. Our prayer is that God will lift the effects of long-covid, as well as the fibromyalgia, multiple allergies, and chronic fatigue syndrome that she has suffered from for years, and that he will let her experience his blessings in a comprehensive way.

Nisin and Joanna Serving in Restricted Area


