Commissioning Prayer Time for Summer Missions - Sunday Evening, May 14

Your Outreach and Missions team at Christ Covenant is excited to commission the mission trips below. This summer five different teams will be traveling to assist in serving churches and gospel ministries in our city, country and internationally. In the evening worship service, we will intentionally set aside time to commission our teams being sent out with prayer. Here is a summary of the teams.

Campus Outreach Leadership Project on May 24 - July 20: Campus Outreach is hosting an eight-week training project in Orlando, FL called the Leadership Project (LP) for college students. The LP is an immersive opportunity for growing spiritual leaders where they can learn how to study God's Word, commune with God in prayer, and share the basics of the gospel with non-believers. Students work jobs and live in community where these disciplines can be lived out.

Serve the City on June 20-23: Middle and high school students will be serving in various capacities locally, including Charlotte Eagles, Starmount ARP, Vive Charlotte PCA church plant, Christ Covenant Church Senior Adult Community and Outreach and Missions department.

Teachers + Missions = Kenya on June 22-30: This team will head to Kenya to support the work of Kibera Reformed Presbyterian Church with Imbumi and Martha Makuku and their school in Kibera by providing a week of teacher training for their staff.

Little Haiti Mission on July 15 - 22 will be serving El Shaddai Ministries International, engaging the Haitian refugee/immigrant community with sports-based outreach and service.

Atlantic City Mission on July 22-29 will be serving with New City Fellowship, a PCA church, engaging the inner-city community with VBS-type camps, multicultural outreach, and service.
