## Prayer of Confession of Sin


#### Assurance of Grace—Isaiah 6:6-7

#### The Nicene Creed

We believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. And we believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord and giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son; who with the

Father and the Son together is worshipped and glorified; who spoke by the prophets; and we believe in one holy catholic and apostolic church; we acknowledge one baptism for the remission of sins; and we look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.


