

## "Yet They Did Not Repent" Sunday Morning, November 19<sup>th</sup>, 2023

Big Idea: "We do not understand what Christianity is all about unless we understand that God is even now commanding all people everywhere to repent."

- 1. **Review**: Following Kevin's sermon outline, can you name the *who*, *what*, *when*, *where*, and *why* of Rev 9:13-21?<sup>2</sup>
- 2. **Gospel**: Why do you think *repentance* is often left out when sharing the gospel?
- 3. **Deception**: "The main way that Satan works in the world is by telling falsehoods."
  - a. Why is knowing this so important to living the Christian life?
  - b. Think about lies that are you tempted to believe about God, yourself, others. How do we combat these in real time?
- 4. **Hindrances**: "You be you' is not the hope of the world, but the judgment of God." Can you think of other worldly ideas which are hindrances to repentance?
- 5. **Megaphone**: C.S. Lewis writes, "Pain insists upon being attended to. God whispers to us in our pleasures, speaks in our consciences, but shouts in our pains. It is his megaphone to rouse a deaf world." Have you seen this to be true in your own life?
- 6. **Embarrassment and Regret**: What is the difference between embarrassment and repentance? ...regret and repentance?
- 7. **Rock Bottom**: Kevin mentioned that when some hit rock bottom, "they start digging." How do we see this in our text? How do we see this in our world?
- 8. **Pray**: Take a moment and pray for loved ones who are running from God. Pray also for our own hearts, that our hearts would be soft to the conviction of the Spirit.
