SPECIAL OFFERING FOR CHRIST COVENANT AFGHAN REFUGEE MINISTRY

Our February special offering will go to support the Christ Covenant Afghan Refugee Ministry. This ministry began when our United States troops were pulled out of Afghanistan in August 2021. Many Afghan's that had fought alongside or served our military in some capacity were rescued from the new Taliban regime and brought here to the United States. While the mission field is global, now some of the mission field became our new neighbors when they moved here to Matthews. As a church, we were called to help in some way.

We began by caring for one family, the Mohammadi family (Dad, Mom and four young children). For the last two years, God has blessed this ministry as we have joined arms with other churches to serve this refugee community that lives in the Charlotte area. Now the ministry has expanded to include many Afghan refugee families. We build relationships with these families as we serve to meet some of their immediate needs such as learning English, learning to drive, tutoring for their children, household set-up, and other assimilation needs. Your gift will be used to continue the growth of this Christ Covenant ministry as we serve, care, and develop deeper relationships with our Afghan friends.
