



Sermon Discussion Guide¹

Rev 15:1-8 | Kevin DeYoung

“The Song of Moses and the Song of the Lamb”
Sunday Morning, March 10th, 2024

1. Considering the Bible as a hymnal, what songs from Scripture have helped you, encouraged you, instructed you over the years?
2. What does the promise of “standing beside the sea of glass” hold for those who were victorious over the constant attack and assault of the beast? What does it promise for us?
3. Discuss this picture of salvation: “Sometimes providences like Hebrew letters must be read backwards”²?
4. Read the song of Moses in Exodus 15. This is *our song*. How is it possible that we sometimes want to go back to Egypt? How might meditating on this song give us strength to press forward to the Promised Land?
5. Regarding singing in worship, Kevin made the statement: “The main question is not ‘what do unbelievers think or even ‘what do I think’, but the main question is ‘what does GOD think’.” Discuss this principle.
6. Consider the songs that you shared from the intro question. How do those songs *teach you* about God? What hope do you have as you think about “gaining the whole counsel of God from a lifetime of singing”?
7. Thinking about music in worship, are you typically more engaged in the corporate experience or your own private experience? Read Genesis 2:18, Proverbs 18:1, Ecclesiastes 4:9-10, and Hebrews 10:23-25. What do you learn that informs your understanding of the corporate experience?
8. What seven attributes of God do you see in the song recorded in Rev. 15:3,4? What three responses are recorded? How do those responses resonate with your experience of worshipping Christ?
9. How has this text disciplined you? Are you thinking differently about what you sing when the choice is yours? What practical changes can you make to embrace this song of salvation, making this your personal anthem: “He has become my salvation”?
