COMBINED SUNDAY SCHOOL ON TRANSGENDERISM - APRIL 7, 14 AND 21

Western culture is currently undergoing deep transformation in how people view sexuality and personal identity. Rather than seeing sexuality as a gift to be received from one's Creator, it is increasingly understood as determined by the individual—even down to remaking bodies to align with a sense of sexual identity. This cultural change has brought unprecedented challenges to the Church as she seeks to bear witness to God's Word on what it means to be human, and as she seeks to minister in a deeply confused culture.

This all-church mini-series taught by professors from Reformed Theological Seminary will equip Christians to understand what Scripture teaches on issues related to transgenderism, how we got to this cultural moment, and how Christians might wisely and compassionately minister to others on this issue.

All adults and youth are invited to join us for this combined Sunday Schools on April 7, 14, and 21, in the sanctuary, from 9:00 am - 10:15 am. Senior Pastor Kevin DeYoung will begin the mini-series on April 7 talking about "What does the Bible teach on anthropology related to transgenderism?"
