

Prayer Guide for the week of February 15-21, 2026

Sunday - Our Families, Congregation and Community – Pray for the adult sons and daughters with difficult circumstances, with broken relationships, with major health concerns, or living as prodigals. Pray for parents who have limited contact with their children or grandchildren. Pray for the Lord to bring those who are far away from the Lord to be brought near.

Monday – Supported Workers of the Week - Zach and Amy Fulginiti Serving as Campus Outreach Regional Director in Charlotte, NC

Pray for open hearts on campus – that busy, distracted students would be receptive to the gospel and willing to engage in deeper conversations about faith and truth. Pray for clarity and boldness in evangelism, that the Campus Outreach team would clearly communicate the gospel and faithfully pursue students with wisdom, courage, and love. Pray that students who come to Christ would be established in their faith, grow into reproducing disciples, and be sent into post-grad life prepared to live on mission. Pray for Zach and Amy to have ongoing communion with Christ personally. Pray for ongoing strengthening of their marriage. Pray for their children to walk with Christ for a lifetime.

Tuesday – Local Presbytery - Christ Central Church – Charlotte, NC – Rev. Anthony Myles

Wednesday – Ministries at Christ Covenant Church – Pray for Christ Covenant’s **Merea Ministry**. Merea is a cross-generational group mentoring ministry that seeks to encourage younger women through the experience of older women. Monthly gatherings focus on character and spiritual development and creative activities. Through Merea, younger women have the opportunity to learn life skills, such as gardening, decorating, meal planning, mending and budgeting. Merea mentors use skill training as a platform to build meaningful relationships for sharing life experience and faith stories.

Thursday – Unreached People Group – Awan in Pakistan: The Awan (pronounced, “ah-WAHN”) people number almost six million in Pakistan. There are no known Christian believers among this people group. They have been Muslims for centuries, and Islam is such a significant part of their identity that many never question their religious beliefs. If someone were to leave Islam to follow Jesus, they would face intense persecution from family and friends. The Awan are known for their military skills, and their communities often experience violence and feuding. Pray for the Awan people as they face many barriers to the gospel. Pray for Pakistan, the country where they live. Pray that the Lord would use tools such as TV and radio recordings to share the gospel. The New Testament has been translated into their Punjabi language, so pray that many Awan people will seek to read the Word of God. Pray that many will put their faith in Christ, despite the persecution they may face.

Friday – Our Local Ministry Partners: Pray for **Caleb Ministries**, an organization that ministers to women and families who have lost a baby through miscarriage, stillbirth, early-infant death, or women who struggle with infertility or who are post-abortive. Pray that resources will reach those who are hurting. Pray for a few ladies who have recently contacted the ministry, that they will be encouraged and comforted during their time of grieving. Praise the Lord for the women and volunteers who generously give their time to create gowns and other items for the P.A.T. (Providing A Treasure) boxes! These boxes are distributed to hospitals and other locations so they may be given to women and families who have experienced the loss of a baby. Pray that the Lord will be near to those who are suffering and that the materials provided by Caleb Ministries will offer hope during a dark season.

Saturday - Our Servant Leaders/Our Church - Pray for our pastors and their wives and families. Pray for these families to be protected from evil. Pray for family time to be rich and unifying. Pray for the Lord to strengthen each marriage.
