

Prayer Guide for the week of May 10-16, 2026

Sunday - Our Families, Congregation and Community – Pray for the moms in our congregation to serve their families in a way that honors the Lord. Pray for the families and individuals in our congregation who have recently lost their mother. Pray for them as they grieve that they would lift their eyes to the Lord. Pray for the women in our church who are waiting and longing to be a mother. Pray for the Lord to strengthen them in the waiting. Praise the Lord for mothers!

Monday – Supported Workers of the Week - Trent and Kat Thomas serving as Church Planters in Monroe, NC - Pray for Christ Hills PCA. Pray that the Lord would provide a weekly attendance of more than 150 people to hear the gospel. Pray for 10 adult baptisms by the end of 2026. Pray that their growth groups would be effective in forming mature disciples and reaching neighbors, colleagues, and friends. Pray for Trent and Kat to remain steadfast in the ordinary means of grace and weekly family worship, to engage non-Christian families in Monroe and in Wingate. Pray for Trent and Kat to prioritize the discipleship of their children while also nurturing their physical, social, and emotional development.

Tuesday – Local Presbytery - Redeemer Church – Southern Pines, NC – Rev. Bo Collins

Wednesday – Ministries at Christ Covenant Church – Pray for Christ Covenant’s **Children’s Ministry**. Children’s Ministry seeks to serve the church by educating children, equipping parents, and engaging volunteers so that the Kingdom of God might be glorified. Pray for the Lord to bring the 300 volunteers that are needed to serve in the Children’s Ministry during 2026-2027. Pray for the staff as they recruit for these positions this month. Pray for the Lord to move in our congregation and for our members to have a desire to serve our covenant children.

Thursday – Unreached People Group – Dharhi in India: The Dharhi (pronounced, “TAH-dee”) people are split into two religious groups: Muslims and Hindus. Dharhi people traditionally followed Hinduism until Muslim invaders overtook the Uttar Pradesh region in India. Now, only a small community of 25,000 Dharhi people continue to follow Hinduism, creating a religious divide between the people groups. Pray for the Dharhi people. Pray that they will recognize that they are all walking in spiritual darkness. Pray for Christian influences to shine the light of the gospel so the Dharhi people can have hope in Christ. Pray that the Bhojpuri translation of the Bible will find its way into many Dharhi households. Pray for their hearts to be softened towards the gospel message, so that they can put their trust in the one, true God.

Friday – Our Local Ministry Partners: Pray for **Alongside Families (ASF)**, a ministry that exists to connect isolated families to local church communities that champion family preservation and thriving. Pray for the Mother’s Day Fundraising Campaign. Pray for the Lord to provide for the financial needs of the ministry. Pray for the volunteers needed for Community Friends, Host Families, Support Line Volunteers, and Family Coaches. Pray for the Lord to provide individuals and families who have a desire to serve in this ministry. Pray for a possible work to begin among urban churches and for potential partner churches. Pray for a family who is seeking housing as they explore care for their interim timeframe. Pray for a mom with ongoing medical needs who reached out to learn how the ministry can help her amidst flares and treatments. Pray for additional bi-lingual volunteers for support line intake and for hosting and friending opportunities. Pray for more people to become aware of the ministry of Alongside Families and for agencies and providers to share ASF with parents they are serving. Praise the Lord for the amazing staff who serve so faithfully with excellence!

Saturday – Our Servant Leaders/Our Church – Pray for our staff. Pray that they would make it a priority to seek the Lord and spend time in the Word. Pray for unity to flourish among the staff at Christ Covenant. Pray we would have a staff that is known for their love, not just for the Lord but for one another.
