- 2) Pray for couple that just lost their baby, Paul, and just recently miscarried. Continue to pray that God will open the mother's eyes to spiritual understanding as we go through our **Learning Through Loss** Bible study with the couple. We will be finishing up with this soon so pray that the wife will continually want to meet together.
- 3) Pray for a few volunteers whose husbands are not doing well. Also pray for Ralph, Judy, Larry, and Jeanette who just lost a spouse.
- 4) Continue to pray for Andrea and her husband as they try to conceive again as she had surgery July 21st to be able to carry a baby to term.
